

Work Begins on East Bluff Development Project

Work has begun on two houses in a new project offered by PCCEO, in partnership with Greater Peoria LISC and Peoria Opportunities Foundation. Two homes are under construction on Behrends Ave. in Peoria.

They are the first two homes in the East Bluff Development. Site work in preparation for foundations was completed, trench and water line connections were completed, and concrete footings and foundation

walls formed and poured on 811 and 815 Behrends Avenue. Modules for the homes are being completed and will be set on site by HomeWay Homes by the end of October.

Head Start Offers Full Day Classes at Five Centers

PCCEO Head Start received approval from the Office of Head Start to expand the full day opportunities for Head Start families. Prior to the approval, Head Start had 99 full day slots. Now, 211 full day opportunities have been made available to our Head Start families! We are excited to offer this exceptional educational opportunity to our Head Start families.

We now have full day classrooms at Harrison Community Learning Center (4), Trewyn Park Pavilion (2), Valeska Hinton Early Childhood Education Center (2), Manual Academy (2), and Tri-County (Peoria) Urban League (1). Webster Head Start Center remains a part day center with 11 classrooms. Students at Webster attend school in the morning from 8 am until 11:30 am or in the afternoon from 12:30 pm until 4:00 pm.

The full day center located at Trewyn is an English as a Second Language center. This is the first full day center for our Latino/Hispanic families.

The center at the Tri-County Urban League offers extended care for families who need child care for their children before and after school.
